Daisy Bates Grif Stockley 2005 Daisy Bates (1914-1999) is renowned as the mentor of the Little Rock Nine, the first African Americans to attend Central High School in Little Rock, Arkansas. For guiding the Nine through one of the most tumultuous civil rights crises of the 1950s, she was selected as Woman of the Year in Education by the Associated Press in 1957 and was the only woman invited to speak at the Lincoln Memorial ceremony in the March on Washington in 1963. But her importance as a historical figure has been overlooked by scholars of the civil rights movement. *Daisy Bates: Civil Rights Crusader from Arkansas* chronicles her life and political advocacy before, during, and well after the Central High School crisis. Ultimately, Daisy Bates paints a vivid portrait of an ardent, overlooked advocate of social justice.
